



Project SEARCH Teacher

Term of Employment: Full time, 12 months

Duties/Responsibilities:

- Recruit appropriate students with disabilities for Project SEARCH
- Attend IEP meetings at member districts for selected students
- Coordinate all services with Division of Developmental Disabilities, University of Arizona, UPH Kino Hospital, VocRehab, SAGE and other interested partners and potential work sites
- Teach classroom activities and monitor student worksites each day
- Identify and create solutions for behavioral concerns for any students
- Instruct students in "soft skills" curriculum standards
- Monitor daily attendance and report to sending districts
- Report quarterly grades to home schools—meet with parents and special ed staff at home schools
- Attend advisory meetings with partners as needed
- Coordinate job coach activities and provide input to SAGE for purposes of supervision/evaluation
- Refer students to appropriate agencies for support and services related to successful employment
- Attend trainings and staff meetings as required by JTED
- Perform other duties as deemed necessary and appropriate by JTED staff

Minimum Requirements:

- Must possess a Special Education Teaching certificate and be able to obtain a minimum of a provisional Career & Technical Education Family and Consumer Sciences or a Business and Marketing certificate.
- Bachelors degree in Special Education or related field AND three years teaching experience.
- Maintains licensure/certification, if offered, in a technical field of expertise.

Application Process: Submit cover letter, resume and three letters of reference via mail, email, fax or deliver to the JTED offices. First screening will occur April 1, 2010. OPEN UNTIL FILLED
